### Day One: Saturday, October 9

Effingham, IL

(D)

We will depart **Okmulgee, OK** this morning on our way to New England. We will stop along the way for lunch on our own. This afternoon we will continue our drive and overnight in the **Effingham, IL** area where we will enjoy a delicious **dinner**.

### Day Two: Sunday, October 10

Erie, PA

This morning we will depart **Illinois** and head towards our overnight location in **Erie, Pennsylvania** where we will enjoy an included **dinner**.

### Day Three: Monday, October 11

Boston, MA

Today after breakfast we will arrive in the **Boston** area, where the old thrives with the new – a city rich in history and tradition. We will check into our hotel near Boston which will be our home for the next three nights. This evening a delicious **dinner** is prepared for us.

### Day Four: Tuesday, October 12

Boston, MA

This morning after breakfast we will relive three centuries of history and learn of the Puritans, revolutionaries, immigrants, presidents, and politicians and travel the old streets of Colonial times. On our **Boston City tour** we will see the **Freedom Trail**, the **USS Constitution** which is the oldest ship in the US Navy, **Bunker Hill** and the surrounding areas. Our day in Boston will end at **Quincy Market** and **Faneuil Hall**, a two-story bronze domed building called "The Cradle of Liberty". In pre-Revolutionary times it was the scene of mass public meetings. Today it houses over 100 specialty shops, restaurants and pubs and food vendors. This afternoon a visit to the **JFK Library** is on the agenda. This library displays fascinating memorabilia depicting the life of our nation's 35<sup>th</sup> president from his youth, through his presidency, and his untimely death. Dinner is on our own this evening.

### Day Five: Wednesday, October 13

Boston, MA

This morning, our day will be spent traveling through the lakes and White Mountain region of New Hampshire. Our tour includes a drive along the shores of **Lake Winnepesaukee**, the largest lake in the state. Winnepesaukee translates from its Native American to "Beautiful Place in High Waters," which it truly is. After that, we will visit the magnificent **Castle in the Clouds** for a tour of the castle with its inspiring views of waterfalls and mountains, and get a peek at the natural source of Castle Springs water. The most spectacular feature of the White Mountains is Mt. Washington at 6,288' and known for the worst weather in the world. During fall foliage season the mountains are ablaze with yellows, oranges, and reds. Then we will head back to Boston and enjoy dinner on our own.

### Day Six: Thursday, October 14

Vermont

This morning we will check out of our hotel and explore the green mountain state of Vermont. Our journey today begins to **Quechee Gorge**, Vermont's "little Grand Canyon" to take pictures. Then we will visit the village of **Woodstock**, noted for its well-preserved vintage homes, its village green and covered bridge in the middle of town.

You will be mesmerized by the panorama as you wind past perfectly restored historic buildings and home open to the sprawling Woodstock Village Green. Woodstock treasures include the 200-year old Woodstock Inn, the Billings Farm & Museum and the Covered Bridge. Indulge yourself with a stroll around the Green, through the Covered Bridge, browse the mecca of quaint shops and galleries - let your senses be aroused in this quintessential New England village. Then we will depart Vermont and head to **Syracuse, NY** where we will overnight for one night and enjoy dinner.

**Day Seven: Friday, October 15**

**Niagara Falls, NY (CB)**

Today after breakfast we will head to **Niagara Falls (US side)** for some sightseeing and free time. Later today we will head for **Erie, PA**. Dinner is on our own.

**Day Eight: Saturday, October 16**

**Effingham, IL (CB, D)**

Today, our travels take us back to **Effingham, IL** where we will overnight for one night. Before retiring, dinner is prepared for us.
